Day 1 Arrival at ✈ Islamabad, Pakistan

Day 2 Islamabad -60mins ✈ - Gilgit -2hrs20mins- Karimabad

Catch an early morning flight to Gilgit, offering panoramic views of the Himalayan peaks. From Gilgit, drive to Karimabad, the heart of the Hunza Valley. Immerse yourself in the local culture by exploring the lively Karimabad bazaar and visiting historical sites. Night stay in Hunza



Day 3 20min- Baltit Fort -20min- Altit Fort -20min- Duiker (Eagles Nest) -20min- Karimabad Bazar

Discover the rich history of the region by exploring the ancient Baltit Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continue the cultural journey with a visit to the traditional Altit Village, known for its charming architecture. Enjoy the evening in Karimabad, soaking in the local atmosphere. Also witness the most serene sunset scenes at Eagle's Nest. Night stay in Hunza

Day 4 Aliabad -45min- Attabad Lake -25min- Hussaini Bridge -2hrs- Khunjerab Border

Explore the mesmerizing Attabad Lake, famed for its vivid turquoise waters. Witness the iconic Passu Cones, a photographer's delight, set against the backdrop of dramatic peaks along the majestic Karakorum Highway (KKH). Visit Hussaini Suspension Bridge in Passu. Also witness highest ATM in world and Khunjerab border (Highest border in World). Night stay in Gulmit.




Day 5 Hunza -2hrs 30min- Naltar -1hr- Gilgit

Venture into the scenic Naltar Valley, surrounded by snow-capped peaks and pristine landscapes. Immerse yourself in the beauty of the valley and experience the warm hospitality of the locals. Travel further to Gilgit and explore local Gilgit bazars. Night stay in Gilgit.

Day 6 Gilgit -60mins ✈ - Islamabad Airport-30mins- Lok Virsa -15mins- Faisal Masjid -4hrs-Lahore

Catch a flight from Gilgit back to Islamabad. In Islamabad, explore the Lok Virsa Museum, admire the iconic Faisal Mosque, and travel to Lahore. Embark on a 4 hour by road journey on silky smooth roads to Lahore from Islamabad. Reach Lahore and have dinner at the most beautiful and colorful food street of Lahore with a view of the walled city and Badshahi Mosque. Night stay in Lahore.



Day 7 Hotel -30mins- Lahore Fort -1hr- Wagha Border -5hrs- Islamabad

Spend your day exploring the walled city of Lahore, the narrow historical streets and bazars. Indulge yourself in Mughal History, visit Lahore Fort and Badshahi Mosque. Witness the world famous India-Pakistan Wagha Border Ceremony in the evening. Travel back to Islamabad and drop off at Airport.
